



Southwell School – Duncan & Ebbett Scholarship

Scholarship Details, Conditions & Criteria

The Southwell School Foundation will offer a Duncan & Ebbett Scholarship to support a student entering Southwell in Year 7 in 2025.

The Duncan & Ebbett Scholarship will provide financial support to one student whose financial situation may preclude them from attending Southwell School.

The value of the Duncan & Ebbett Scholarship is a **\$6,000.00 discount off tuition fees per annum for the duration of the student's education at Southwell School in Years 7 and 8.**

Applicants must be NZ Citizens or have permanent residency status and must ordinarily reside in New Zealand.

Applicants must be cared for by a parent or legal guardian.

If awarded, the parent/guardian on behalf of the applicant acknowledges that this scholarship must be kept confidential.

The applicant demonstrates considerable promise and commitment to achieve their full potential in more than one area but not limited to academic/sporting/musical/cultural achievement.

Application for the Duncan & Ebbett Scholarship will be accepted only if presented on the attached application form with required enclosures by the closing date.

The Headmaster reserves the right to withdraw a scholarship if a child's conduct and/or progress is not maintained at a high standard.

The admission of a student and the duration of the student's attendance at the school are matters entirely for the decision of the Trust Board at its discretion.

The parent/guardian acknowledges that the information collected in this form will be used by Southwell School for the purposes of being considered for this scholarship. Only authorised Southwell School staff will have access to this information.

Key Information

1. Applications must be received by **Friday 31 May 2024.**
2. Applications will be acknowledged by the Registrar, by email, when received.
3. Applicants will be shortlisted and interviewed by the Southwell School Headmaster. Interviews will be scheduled by the Southwell School Registrar.
4. The Scholarship is awarded only when the selection committee are satisfied that the scholarship criteria has been attained. The level of funding will be at the Headmasters discretion.
5. All applicants will be advised of the outcome of their application in writing.
