



Founder's Day Beginnings

Along with Mr Cecil Ferris who was Southwell's founder and first Headmaster, the Sergel family is also an important part of Southwell's history as on 1 November 1963 the four children of Mr Henry Godfrey Sergel (Southwell's second Headmaster) gifted the land and buildings of Southwell School to become a non-profit making Education Institution administered by a Trust Board under the terms of a formulated Trust Deed. At the same time the Trust Board was formed, the Fellows (who are guardians of the Trust Deed) were appointed for the first time. The Fellows hold their AGM at the School on 1 November each year and join with the students and staff for the annual celebration of Founder's Day.

From The Library

Your Kids Next Read is a fabulous Facebook group and podcast which endeavours to help parents, teachers and librarians to help their child find their next read.

Below is a snippet from a recent blog post with advice around keeping your kids reading during the business of Term 4, and also links to intel as to why Holiday Reading is so important (Look out for our the Southwell Holiday Reading info later in the term.)

IT'S BUSY EVERYONE IS TIRED READING CAN GO BY THE WAYSIDE



To help, we asked Megan Daley for her best tips to help keep up the reading momentum in the face of chaotic family calendars, fatigue and waning interest.

- Set your expectations for your kids and their reading.
- Sign them up to a reading challenge or create one. (Start by downloading our printable reading bookshelf, which you can adjust to suit your child.)
- Curate their reading for the term. Having books on hand is half the battle with reading, so head to the bookshop or library and help your reader select options for the term. Rotate the books on their bookshelves.
- Change out the books you have in the car for your car library. A mobile library in your car can be a terrific way to fill waiting time!

"Term 4 passes in the blink of an eye," says Megan, "but reading makes it that little bit softer and gentler. If you have it all prepped, you're ahead of the game. It's like a meal plan for the term, but a 'book plan' instead."
